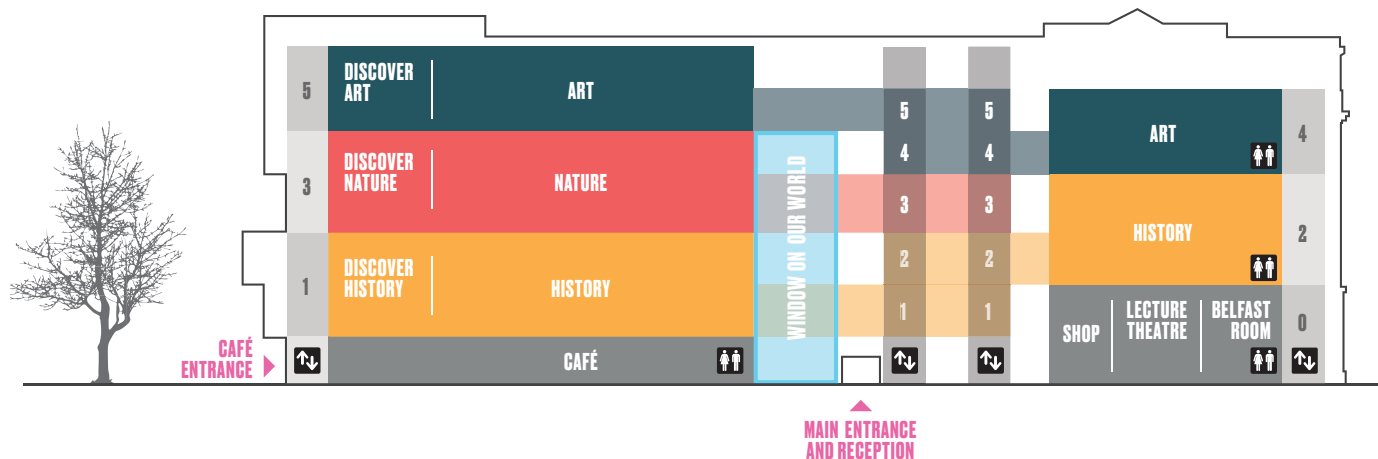
WALCOME TAE THE ULSTER MUSEUM

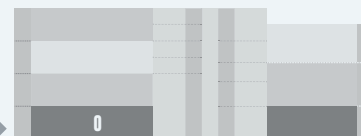

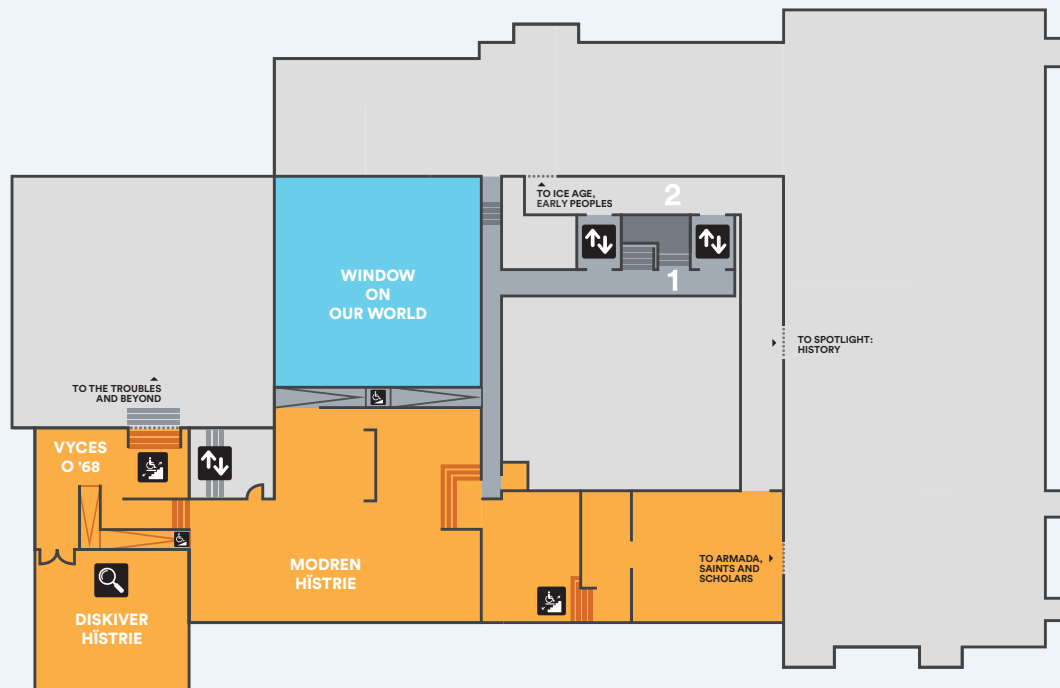

MODREN HİSTRİE 1500 - 1968

Modren Hİstrİe is arrİngİt around paİrtİcular events and themes gİeİng the storİe o the hİstorİc provİnce o Ulster frae 1500 tae 1968. Aİrtİcles oan display İnclude the Dungİven costume, a rare 16th centurİe ondraw recoverİt frae a mire, and the sword o Henry Joy McCracken, weel-forİt İrİshman hİnged in 1798. Monİe o the aİrtİcles İs dİrectİe connectİt tae key events and personaİtİes frae the İest 500 year – frae Hugh O'Neill and Arthur Chİchester, tae İsabella Tod and James Connolly.

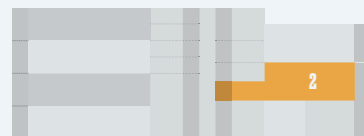

EARLIE FOWKS

Traivel back in time thor wir airchaeologie galleries, frae Airlan's first sattlers (around 8000 BC) tae chynges brocht aboot bi Neolithic fairmers (around 4000 BC). Exploar the Bronze aig (around 2300BC), whin the first gauld and metal airticles wis feingit. Then see airticles frae around 600 BC, the stairt o the Iron Aig.

TAKABUTI

Tak a deek at hoo fowk in Egypt leeved syne thoosands o year and learn aboot the life and deith o Takabuti. Nearaboots, ye'll fin a bairn's wuiden dall, hair kames, jewellerie and cosmetic jars that ware ance in deylie uiss.

ARMADA

Tales o tragedie and treisur aboond in this collection, whit recks internaitionalle, dedicait tae the forboden Spanish Armada o 1588. The bóats wrackit along the Irish coast include the Girona, full o gauld and personal walth, and La Trinidad Valencera, brimfu o wappens o war.

SAINTS & SCHOLARTS

Diskiver hou the spreid o Christendie in Airlan (around AD 500) wis follaed bi new scribing and airticles maed fer the kirk. Learn aboot the Viking invaders and the end o mediaeval Gaelic Airlan (around AD 1600), mairkit bi evident o conflict.

SPOTLIGHT: HISTRIE

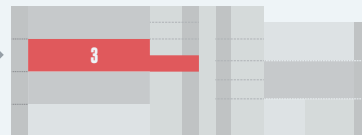

DISKIVER NAITUR

Exploar the naitural world frae exotic shells, butterflees, fossils and minerals, tae local ainimals and birds. Tak a closer leuk at mintie beasties unner a microscope and git haunds-oan we some o the lairger airticles – ye can even titch an elephant's tail!

FOSSILS AND EVOLUTION

Exploar bi-ordinar fossils frae a 'burial grun' o mintie ammonite shells tae a toothy, fower-metre lang fish. See skulls o droichlin elephants and etin deer. Diskiver why yer skeleton isnae sae different frae a monkey, a moose or a mowdie.

LEEIVING WARLD

Learn mair aboot life oan the yird – baith past and praisent. Exploar fossil gaur, the ferlie shells o ammonites and the ootlin foarms o the trilobites. See modren crossocks, etin clams and an emperor penguin. Mairvel at the coelocanth, a fish thocht tae be extinct untae 1938, and the Passenger Doo, weedit awa bi 1914.

OREEGINS/THE YIRD'S TREISURS.

Titch a crottle o a planet's coar, foarmit at the creek o wor Solar Sistem syne 4.5 billion year. Wunner at the ringe o minerals and cristals fand oan the yird, and the UK's laigest display o minerals whit glim brichtlie unner ultraviolet licht.

SPOTLIGHT: NAITUR

Wor barrie collections include sae monie science specimens that we can anelie shaw a fraction o them aa at ane time. This gallerie hosts chynging science displays frae aa around the glób, and ayont.

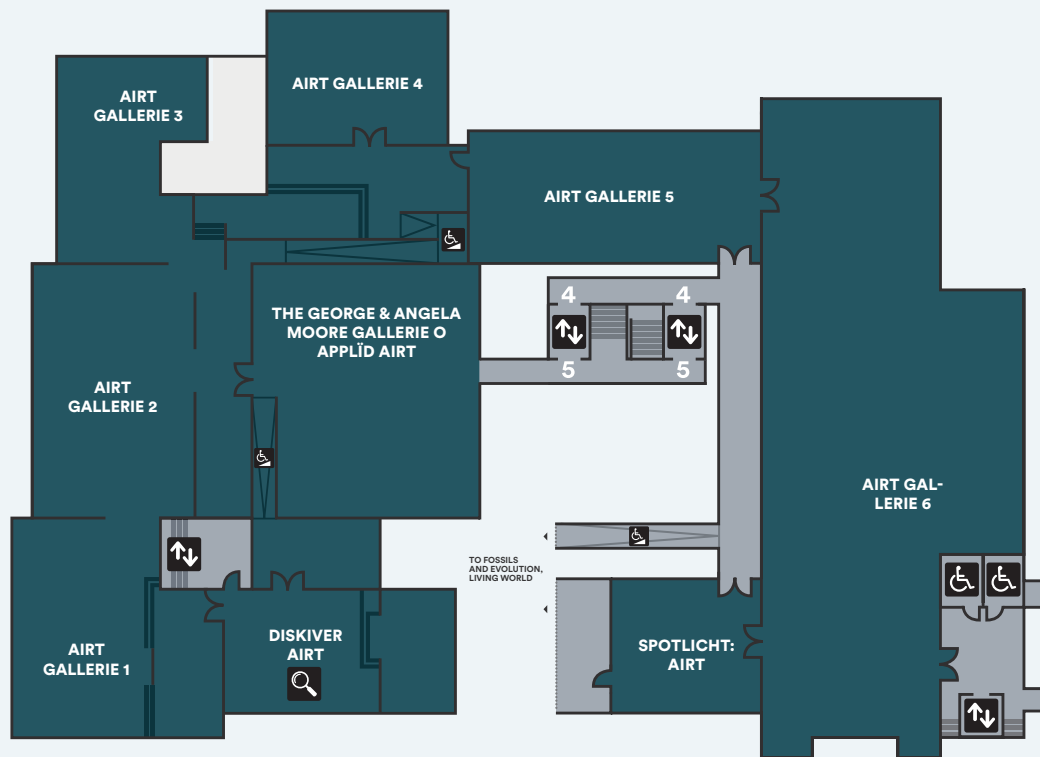
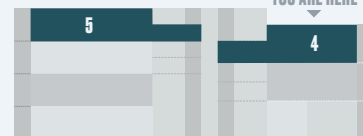

ULSTER FOWK MUSEUM



Stap backward in time and experience whit life wis lyke in Ulster mair than 100 year ago.

The Ulster Fowk Museum is an appen-air, leeving hīstrie museum centert oan the bizzing market toon o Ballycultra, fillt wi aithentic biggings, eich luvnglie transportit frae thir original settings. Watch a talkie at the pictér hoose, sen a letter at the poast office, or treat yersel tae some sweets frae the coarner shap.

Fowk here leeve and dress the same wey as thir forbeirs. Meet a blacksmith wirking iron at the smiddie. Blether wi the basket makkar as ye ettle yir haund at

weaving rashes, wicker or strae. Daunder intae the landwart, whaur white-washt fairmhooses dot the rowing braes. Ye'll meet wirking ainimals lyke hoarses, cuddies and hens and git a feel o the haurdships and joys o farming life.

ULSTER TRANSPORT MUSEUM



Diskiver ane o the maist impressive transport collections in Europe, curaitit tae cant the storie o technological and social chynge in Airlan syne the daw o the modren era.

Ye'll fin pouverfu locomotives, horse-drawn charrits, vintage motorbikes and cars o aa shapes and sizes. These precious machines map the journey o tenacious local fowk finning faster and mair efficient weys tae muive. It is a wall o inspiration fer the designers, inginĩrs and anterers o the futur.

Must-see exhibits include an oreeginal DeLorean car, biggit in

Norlin Airlan and maed famous bi the Back to the Future trilogie, Maedb the maist pouverfu steam locomotive iver tae ply the trecks o Airlan, and the Short SC1, an earlie vertical tak-aff fechter jet.

ULSTER AMERICAN FOWK PAIRK

Set aff oan an epíc jurney across the centuries and the braid Atlantic Ocean as ye diskiver the storie o Irish emigration. Diskiver the world o landwart Ulster that the migrants left ahind, the neef jurney they endurt at sea and the colonial sociétie whit they jyned in Americae

Ander thro the landwart world o nineteenth century Ulster, carefullie recreautit in the oreeginal biggings that wis muived stane-bi-stane frae

whaur they stuid lang syne. Tak ship aboard the Brig Union, a close replica o a genuine migrant transport. Exploar the New World and the ingenie solutions whit new arrivals fordert tae answer the tests o leeving on the frontier.

Experience the past thro haunds-oan aicivities sic as flax spinning, bern reels and traditional cuiking. Watch blacksmiths and rope makkars at wirk or sit in oan a schuil lesson.
